1. Leviticus 7:12

"If he offers it for **thanksgiving**, then he shall offer, with the sacrifice of thanksgiving, unleavened cakes mixed with oil, unleavened wafers anointed with oil, or cakes of blended flour mixed with oil."

2. Leviticus 7:13

"Besides the cakes, as his offering, he shall offer leavened bread with the sacrifice of **thanksgiving** of his peace offering."

3. Leviticus 7:15

11. 2 Chronicles 31:2

"And Hezekiah appointed the divisions of the priests and the Levites according to their divisions, each man according to his service, the priests and Levites for burnt offerings and peace offerings, to serve, to **give thanks**, and to praise in the gates of the camp of the LORD."

12. Nehemiah 11:17

13. Nehemiah 12:8

14. Nehemiah 12:24

16. Nehemiah 12:38
